COMMERCIAL CLUB ALBURY GOLD CUP CARNIVAL

The Albury Racing Club is pleased to confirm that races scheduled to run over Thursday and Friday of the Commercial Club Albury Gold Cup Carnival will go ahead as planned, made possible by Racing NSW support.

Due to restrictions imposed by the Commonwealth Government, Racing NSW has advised the Club that only essential personnel are permitted to enter the venue and there is no public access allowed.

Attendance will only be provided to essential personnel, which on race day is restricted to the following:

- Racing NSW Stewards and Veterinarians
- Trainers, Jockeys and Stablehands with a runner at the race meeting
- Barrier Attendants, Starters and essential Track Staff
- Clerks of the Course
- Judges and Sectional Timing Teams
- Weighing Room Staff and Jockeys Attendants
- Raceday Event Staff and security including horse stalls, mounting yards and float car park
- Club Doctor and Ambulance Services
- Farriers and other essential service providers approved by Racing NSW and the Race Club
- Broadcast services including Race Caller
- Restricted Core Racing Media as approved by Racing NSW and the Race Club
- Restricted operational Race Club staff and management

The Albury Racing Club is aware of the volatility of the current situation and we are liaising with Racing NSW throughout each day to ensure the club is taking all precautions necessary. We will continue to provide you with regular updates when changes occur.

We apologise for the disappointment this is causing our members, sponsors, corporate partners and those that were planning to attend the Commercial Club Albury Gold Cup Carnival. We appreciate your continued support and understanding in what is an unprecedented situation.
